Independence and care

At Home

Possability People At Home takes a fresh approach to providing care and support to people in their own homes. With an experienced and capable staff team, we support people with age related impairments, complex mental health, learning disabilities and physical and sensory impairments.

We can help you with domestic duties, personal care, medication management and medical care. We put together bespoke arrangements with no calls less than an hour and have a 'Good' Care Quality Commission rating'.

Payroll

Our Payroll service can take tax, national insurance, pensions, timesheets, making payments on time, and other associated paperwork off your hands so you can get on with other things. We also support people using direct payments to manage their supported bank account by providing help and guidance to manage their paperwork and bills. All it takes is a quick [email](#) to get the ball rolling.

Help and advice

Our team of independent advisors can talk to you about: benefits (ESA, UC, PIP, AA, Carers Allowance, WTC); appealing your disability benefits; housing option forms; Blue Badge and bus pass applications; some pension credit enquiries; information on equipment or assistive technology; accessible holidays; food bank referrals. We meet the Advice Quality Standard.

Supporting you

Our community employment team will support you to move into work. We offer workshops, courses and 1:1 support to build confidence, manage your health, create CVs, develop interview techniques and build digital skills. If you're thinking about work, or how to get into it, you will not regret sending them an [email](#).

Our Hospital Discharge Support specialists work at The Royal Sussex County Hospital with older and disabled people who are well enough to leave hospital but need extra support to get on with their lives. They can access grants for things like cleaning and adaptations to get you safely home more quickly.

Our Right Track team are all about helping you manage aches and pain so you can become or remain more active. We will link you into support and activity near you to help you improve your health and wellbeing or you could join our online gentle exercise classes, called [Steady and Strong](#).

Volunteering

We have a wide range of accessible opportunities, from administration and reception, to project support, to communications, to Shopmobility delivery driving, to advisors and more.

Our volunteers are a valued part of our team. They learn new skills, gain confidence and self esteem, and often find work after volunteering. Volunteering looks great on a CV and can improve employment prospects. We offer training opportunities, regular support meetings and the all important social activities and events. Get Involved

We support disabled people to feedback their experiences in a way which is useful for other people.

Our Get Involved Group (the GIG) represents our views at council and health meetings, and beyond. These views feed into planning processes and can improve the way services are delivered.

It's also a very sociable group and has helped people stay in touch with each other during the pandemic. The GIG meets regularly, in accessible venues, although at the moment, it is meeting online. Focus groups, online and offline consultations, a regular newsletter and our Safe At Home groups have been keeping members connected and busy.

It's fully equipped with a portable smart board with built in projector, full PA system and WIFI.
